Earlier records are not always clear about elections to honorary membership. For a period, from about 1983, retiring members were entitled to hon. membership if they personally wished it. The letters El. are not included on the list in these instances. Of the 43 one year chairmen between 1947 and 1985, 17 were elected to hon. membership and 18 were ordained. From 1985 (when chairmen held office for two years) to the present day, all chairmen have been elected to hon. membership but only one has been ordained.

The list serves as a fitting reminder of several choral foundations that are no longer with us; Eton, Chester, Winchester College, Clifton College, St Michael's Tenbury, Tewkesbury Abbey and All Saints Margaret Street in London.
